



Restoring MS SQL 2000 backups

***Note:** Before you begin reading this tutorial, please see Appendix A as it provides important setup information for your SQL 2005 Server.

1. Start > Programs > Vision Backup > Vision Backup.
2. Click on Restore Backup.
3. Select Restore from a list of known backups and click next.
4. Select the SQL backup you would like to restore.
5. Select "Specify a location to restore to". (Specify any location, EX) c:\Temp)
6. Select the location of the Backup Files and click next.
7. The restore completes and places your file in the location stated on the restore window. In this example the path to the SQL File is:
C:\OpenFileBackup\
8. Browse to the location specified by the restore window. You will notice the SQL File that now needs to be imported by SQL Enterprise Manager.
9. Start > Programs > Microsoft SQL Server > Enterprise Manager.
10. Expand the Server
11. Right Click the Database that you would like to restore and select All Tasks then Restore Database.
12. Select From device and click Select Devices Button.
13. Click on the Add Button.
14. Click the browse button.
15. Browse to the location of our restored backup and click on the .db file and click ok.
In this example the path to the SQL File is:
C:\OpenFileBackup\
16. Click Ok.
17. Click Ok Again.
18. Select Restore backup set and select Database – complete and click ok.
19. You will begin to see the restore progress.
20. You're done!
